
## Get started on the mobile ONE-KEY™ app.

- •The homepage, or **Inventory Dashboard**, will display on your screen.


## How to use the Inventory Audit feature.


1. Starting at the home screen of the One-Key mobile app, click the "**Places**" icon near the bottom of the display.




- •The place of a particular item is set either when it is first configured into One-Key, or as it is moved and scanned from one place to another.

3. Now that the place of your choosing is selected, scroll to the bottom and click the "**Audit Inventory**" button.




- 4. All your One-Key enabled tools and items in the area will begin to display on the screen.
