- •Tap the red "**Send Email**" button. •You'll soon receive an email with a link to reset your password.




Whether it's due to security concerns or just a matter of preference, you may find it's time to change your account password, and One-Key makes it easy to do this right from your admin account.

•Along the top of your One-Key web account, click your profile photo. This will open a menu with a few different options.




•Click "View my profile."
